Although the team has not won a game in nearly a month (Dec. 4), WMU is a perfect 4-0-0 in nonconference play this season. The Broncos opened the 2009-10 campaign with back-to-back series sweeps which includes a pair of 2-1 victories over the University of Alabama-Huntsville in Huntsville, Ala. Oct. 23-24 which propelled the Broncos into the top 25 nationally. However, in the 14 games since, WMU has managed just two wins and enters the series winless in their last three contests (0-2-1).

In 2009-10 when BSU has allowed its opponents two-or-fewer goals per game, it is 11-1-0. Through 16 games, BSU currently leads the nation in scoring defense, allowing a meager 1.75 goals per game, while giving up just 1.37 in eight CHA contest.

Ian Lowe enters this weekend riding two-game scoring streak. Lowe registered the Beavers' only goal in a 5-1 loss to MSU and posted the fourth assist of the season in a 3-2 losing effort the following night. Lowe's current point total of 7 goals and four assists stands a career-high.

In 2009-10, BSU is 11-0-0 when it has taken a lead into the third period. Since making the jump to NCAA Division I in 1999-2000, the Beavers are 130-9-12 when leading after two periods of play.

After going 11-2-1 through the first two calendar months of the season, Bemidji State was a meager 2-2 in the month of December. The Beavers enthusiastically flip the calendar to January in hopes of rectifying its first two-game slump of the season. Statistically speaking, BSU has struggled in December, winning just 22 of 60 games since moving to the NCAA Division ranks prior to the 1999-00 season. January however has traditionally been good to the Beavers. BSU has won 68-percent of its games in January since 1999-2000 (35-25-5).

Through 18 games of the 2009-10 season, the Beavers have already posted 11 unassisted goals. That matches the team's Division I-era record set in 2001-02.

Only one current BSU player has any experience versus Western Michigan. Ryan Adams played two games with Wayne State (Mich.) in 2006-07 before transferring to BSU for his sophomore season. He took one shot and finished the weekend with an even plus/minus rating as Wayne was swept by the Broncos.
